**RESOLUTION 2017-214****14-STOREY WOOD BILL**

WHEREAS Nipissing MPP Vic Fedeli has introduced an updated version of the wood frame construction bill he tabled in the Ontario Legislature earlier this year;

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Forestry Revitalization Act (14-Storey Wood Buildings), 2017 received First Reading in the Ontario Legislature;

AND WHEREAS the Act would amend the Ontario Building Code to allow for wood frame construction to be used in mid-rise buildings up to 14 stories, instead of the current six stories;

AND WHEREAS by increasing the use of wood harvested in residential construction, it will help Northern Ontario by providing jobs, and will help Southern Ontario meet targets to reduce urban sprawl and reduce construction costs;

THAT Council supports Nipissing MPP Vic Fedeli's 14-Storey Wood Bill, and that a copy of this resolution be sent to Kathleen Wynne, Premier of Ontario, Vic Fedeli, MPP Nipissing, and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario.
