RESOLUTION 2017-158**MINIMUM WAGE**

WHEREAS the Provincial Government plans to increase the minimum wage to \$15.00/hour by 2019;
AND WHEREAS a 31.6% minimum wage increase will put great financial strain on small business owners in small communities, forcing them to cut back on staff/staff hours, and/or increase the price of their products and services;

AND WHEREAS the increasing costs of products and services will only add to the existing financial stress on the senior population and fixed income Ontarian's;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of Papineau-Cameron requests the Government of Ontario to reconsider the minimum wage increase with a suggested \$0.50 increase annually over 7 years to reach the \$15.00/hour rate. This will give the industry time to adjust to the increases.

AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT a copy of this resolution be sent to the Premier of Ontario, the Minister of Labour, Vic Fedeli Member of Provincial Parliament, and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario.
