RESOLUTION 2023-104

TAX SALE SURPLUS

WHEREAS prior to being repealed by the Modernizing Ontario's Municipal Legislation Act, 2017, Section 380 (6) of the Municipal Act, 2001 allowed for a municipality to retain surplus proceeds from tax sales within their jurisdiction.

AND WHEREAS the Public Tax Sale process is burdensome to a municipality who invest a considerable amount of time and money recovering these proceeds for the potential sole benefit of the Crown in Right of Ontario.

THAT the Council of Papineau-Cameron requests the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing to reinstate previous legislation that permitted a Municipality to apply for and retain the surplus proceeds from a tax sale in their jurisdiction.

AND FURHTER THAT the Hon. Steve Clark Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, the Hon. Peter Bethlenfalvy Minister of Finance, the Hon. Victor Fedeli MPP Minister of Economic Development, Job Creation and Trade, and the Association of the Municipalities of Ontario be provided a copy of this resolution.
