MUNICIPAL DRAINS

WHEREAS K.Smart Associates Consulting Engineers & Planners are the Township of Papineau-Cameron's municipal drain superintendent and work in accordance with the municipal drain assessment schedules for the municipal drains located within the Township of Papineau-Cameron;

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture Food and Rural Affairs, Agricultural Drainage Infrastructure Maintenance Program for Northern Ontario covers two thirds, and the property owners named in the municipal drain assessment schedule cover one third of the costs of the excavation drain cleaning.
